Supplies for making Murthis

You will need a small piece of clay or homemade modeling dough. As much as possible, please use natural, eco friendly materials. Small amounts of clay can be obtained at craft stores.



Supplies for performing Puja

- 1. A piece of yellow string, thread, or ribbon that will be placed around the Ganesha as a garland. You can also make a small garland at home with flowers if you prefer.
- 2. A sweet to offer as prasad after the puja chocolate kisses or any other sweet is fine.
- 3. A small amount each of sandalwood paste and kumkum (ceremonial red powder). These can also be mentally visualized.
- 4. A plate or tray to place the Ganesh on for the puja
- 5. A small lamp or candle that can be lit for the puja
- 6. A few flower petals if you have access to flowers. This can be mentally visualized.
